

# Annual Fuel Price Report 2022



The RACQ's Annual Fuel Price Report for 2022 provides key fuel price data and analysis for 2022.

## Key Points

- At 184.9 cpl, the average retail price of regular 91 RON unleaded petrol (RULP) for Brisbane in 2022 was the highest on record, exceeding the 2021 average (previous record high) by 34.1 cpl.
- Record high monthly and daily average RULP and diesel prices were observed throughout Queensland in 2022.
- These record highs were caused by an increase in the oil price following the Russian invasion of Ukraine and the subsequent international sanctions. Sanctions against Russia further limited the already tight oil market caused by OPEC (the oil producer cartel) limiting production.
- The average indicative retail margin for RULP sold in Brisbane for 2022, at 14.0 cpl, was 2.3 cpl lower than 2021.
- Indicative refinery margins, at 17.5 cpl, were 11.3 cpl higher than 2021 (at 6.2 cpl), and the highest on record.
- The sum of indicative retail, wholesale and refiner margins on RULP sold in Brisbane in 2022 was 38.7 cpl, 9.0 cpl higher than 2021 (at 29.7 cpl), another record high.
- RULP sold in Brisbane (at 184.9 cpl) was the most expensive of the five largest capital cities, closely followed by Melbourne at 184.6 cpl. Adelaide was the cheapest capital at 178.5 cpl, 6.4 cpl cheaper than Brisbane. The average for Perth, Sydney and Melbourne was 180.1 cpl, 183.9 cpl and 184.6 cpl, respectively. Darwin, Canberra and Hobart were more expensive than Brisbane at 188.9 cpl, 189.0 cpl and 191.3 cpl, respectively.
- Bundaberg was the cheapest place to buy RULP in Queensland in 2022, at 176.6 cpl.
- The average price of diesel in Brisbane in 2022 was 209.2cpl, 65.4cpl higher than 2021. Indicative retail margins, at 17.2cpl, were 4.6 cpl higher than 2021. Retail margins on diesel were especially high towards the end of 2022, reaching 29.8 cpl in December.
- Indicative refinery margins, at 36.8 cpl, were 33.2 cpl higher than 2021 (at 3.6cpl), and the highest on record. While Australian refiners enjoyed these windfall margins, the high margins were caused by high benchmark prices in Singapore.
- At 209.2 cpl, diesel sold in Brisbane in 2022 was the most expensive of the five largest capital cities. Only the smaller capitals were more expensive. Perth was the cheapest capital to buy diesel at 203.2 cpl, 6.0 cpl cheaper than Brisbane.
- Miles was the cheapest place to buy diesel in Queensland in 2022, with an average of 203.0 cpl.
- Looking forward to 2023, oil prices and retail fuel prices are likely to be slightly lower than 2022.




## RULP Price Breakdown

The figure below presents a price breakdown for RULP sold in Brisbane in 2022 and 2021 (the dearest and second dearest), and 2016 and 2014 (the cheapest year and third dearest year in the last ten years).



## Diesel Price Breakdown

The figure below presents a price breakdown for diesel sold in Brisbane in 2022 (the dearest), 2021 (last year), and 2016 and 2014 (the cheapest year and second dearest year in the last ten years).



## International Benchmark Prices

Oil and petrol are traded globally in very high volumes. Therefore, Australia is a price taker for all automotive fuels. The Terminal Gate Price (TGP) - the key wholesale price for all liquid automotive fuels in the Australian market - is strongly correlated to Singapore wholesale/benchmark prices and oil prices. For RULP the refined product benchmark is Singapore MOGAS and for diesel the benchmark is Singapore GASOIL.

The table below summarises the annual average prices of the Singapore benchmarks – MOGAS and GASOIL, and the international crude oil benchmark – Brent.


The average price for Brent crude oil in 2022 was AU\$ 142.34 per barrel (US\$ 99 per barrel), with significant fluctuations in the average prices during the year. The lowest average monthly price was AU\$ 116.40 in January 2022, and the highest was AU\$ 162.10 in June 2022. By December 2022, the average had declined to AU\$ 138.20, due to a significant decline over six months in the US dollar price of Brent crude oil, partly offset by a fall in the value of the Australian dollar against the US dollar.

The factors leading to the fluctuations in the oil price included: the impacts on oil supply and exports from Russia due to the war between Russia and Ukraine, the resulting sanctions against Russia, changing economic conditions and prospects in oil importing countries, increasing interest rates leading to slower economic growth or reduced growth expectations, decisions by OPEC member countries (which account for 40% of world oil production) about production volumes, and increased US oil production and releases from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve, which assisted in reducing prices in the second half of the year.

The sanctions against Russia have caused additionally tightness in the international diesel market, over and above that observed in the oil market. This is evident by the elevated Singapore GASOIL price and diesel TGP in Queensland, especially in the second half of 2022.

The figure below displays the price trends for the Brent crude oil price, the Singapore MOGAS and GASOIL prices, the average Brisbane TGP, the Brisbane retail price for RULP and diesel, and the AU\$/US\$ exchange rate.

Looking forward to 2023, the weakness in the global economy is likely to continue to weigh on oil prices. Currently, predictions for the average Brent price for 2023 are sitting at between 90 and 100 US\$/bbl, with the US Energy Information Agency predicting an average price of 95 US\$/bbl. At the current exchange rate, a Brent price of 95 US\$/bbl equates to about 135 AU\$/bbl, slightly lower than the average for 2022. In turn, this should equate to slightly lower average retail petrol and diesel prices in 2023, compared to 2022. However, oil prices are highly volatile and at times may be substantially higher or lower than the predicted average.

### **The Fuel Excise Reduction**

In the March 2022 Federal Budget, fuel excise was cut by 50% for six months. This measure was introduced on 30 March 2022 and ended on 29 September 2022. This resulted in the excise rate for ULP and diesel being 22.1 cpl until 1 August, when the excise increased in line with the increase in CPI in the first half of 2022 to 23.0 cpl.

On 29 September 2022, the excise returned to the full rate of 46.0 cpl. Including the effect of GST, wholesale fuel prices increased by 25.3 cpl. In metropolitan Brisbane, the return of excise to the full rate had little immediate impact on petrol prices, as retailers had increased margins to a high level by late September, and absorbed the excise increase in a lower margin initially. Diesel prices in South-East Queensland, and petrol and diesel prices in regional centres increased following the excise increase.

While the excise reduction offset some the spike in oil prices observed in the middle of 2022, most centres in Queensland observed record high RULP prices in June. Without the excise cut these record high prices would have been about 24 cpl greater, and the daily average RULP in Brisbane may have

spiked at about 246 cpl. When the full rate of excise was reintroduced in September the Brent oil price and Singapore MOGAS price had eased. However, the Singapore GASOIL price remained elevated, due to tightness in international diesel markets. Subsequently retail diesel prices in Queensland spiked at new highs in November 2022, before easing slightly in December.

## Price Records

A new record high daily average RULP price of 221.4 cpl was observed in Brisbane on 20 June 2022. Prior to 2022, the previous record was 186.3 cpl, observed on 12 November 2021 (however, the highest price from 2021 price was exceeded on many days in 2022).

A new record high the monthly average price of 205.9 cpl was observed in June 2022. The previous (pre-2022) all-time record high of 170.6 cpl (observed in November 2021). The monthly average ULP price for every month in 2022 was higher than the previous (November 2021) record high.

2022 also saw a new record annual average RULP price of 184.9 cpl, 34.1 cpl higher than the previous high of 150.8 cpl observed in 2021.

New record highs were set in all regional centres for both ULP and diesel. The tables below present a summary of the record high prices observed in Queensland. These records are only for centres surveyed by RACQ. Prices in other centres may have exceeded the prices presented below.

## Regional Queensland

With an average RULP price of 176.6 cpl, Bundaberg was the cheapest place to buy RULP in Queensland in 2022, as it was 2021. Bundaberg was also second cheapest in 2020. The Bundaberg average RULP price was 8.3 cpl lower than the average price of 184.9 cpl in Brisbane. Whitsunday was the second cheapest at 177.1 cpl, and Hervey Bay and Miles joint third at 177.9 cpl. Gympie, Gladstone, Townsville, Beaudesert, Kingaroy, Warwick, Roma, Nambour, Yeppoon, Rockhampton, Dalby, Goondiwindi, Ingham, Cairns, Maryborough, Somerset, Bowen, Lockyer Valley, Toowoomba, Innisfail, Charters, Blackwater, Gold Coast and Sunshine Coast were also cheaper than Brisbane. Longreach, with an average RULP price of 209.2 cpl, retained the position as the most expensive<sup>1</sup>. Longreach has held the dubious honour of most expensive centre since 2018.

Miles had the cheapest diesel in Queensland in 2022 at an average of 203.0 cpl, 6.2 cpl cheaper than the Brisbane price of 209.2 cpl. Gympie, Bundaberg, Gladstone, Hervey Bay, Somerset, Nambour, Whitsunday, Warwick, Goondiwindi, Noosa, Roma, Toowoomba, Lockyer Valley, Bowen, Yeppoon, Beaudesert, Rockhampton, Blackwater, Maryborough, Dalby, Townsville, Kingaroy, Charters and Innisfail were also cheaper than Brisbane. Like with RULP, Longreach, with an average diesel price of 222.9 cpl, was the most expensive centre in Queensland<sup>1</sup>.

The tables below display the average retail price and average indicative retail margin for RULP and diesel in major Queensland cities and towns, and interstate capitals.

## Data Sources

All data presented in this report is RACQ derived work from calculations based on data primarily from OPIS, with some additional data from other sources<sup>2</sup>.

The data presented in the report is the best available data at the time of publication. The data presented in this report supersedes all previous reports.
